
REACT Fellowship: Credits & Academic Recognition

The **REACT Fellowship** is a deeply immersive, real-world learning program built to complement and expand traditional education. While it does not confer a formal degree or diploma, its design is aligned with national credit frameworks and global best practices in experiential learning—making it both academically meaningful and future-ready.



REACT Credit Structure

The full REACT Fellowship is equivalent to 18 REACT credits, each representing 45 to 60 hours of:


- Field immersion
- Guided learning
- Reflection
- Solution-building

Breakdown:

- 3 credits Field immersion and lived experience documentation
- 3 credits Problem extraction, ideation, and validation
- 12 credits Project development, implementation, and evaluation


While the standard duration is 6 months,

Participants typically complete this journey in 6 to 18 months. While the standard duration is 6 months, extensions of 3, 6, or 12 months are available based on project needs and performance reviews.

- Cumulative
- Flexible
- Centered on demonstrable learning outcomes

Where agreements are in place, REACT credits may be used for:

- Contributing to elective or interdisciplinary credits
- Supplementing portfolios for capstone or minor projects
- Fulfilling institutional criteria for applied learning experiences

Even where formal transfer is not yet applicable, REACT credits serve as an academically structured, mentor-evaluated record of learning.


